TASK Force – Leadership Training Program for 2012

We have an on-going leadership program to raise up a new generation of young leaders who will be in Year 7 next year. TASK is an acronym for Training And Serving Kids. It is designed to equip and train children in the areas of leadership, spiritual life and ministry

Training is provided by gifted leaders within ROAR. We will be exploring biblical principles to disciple and encourage your child to grow in God's Word that will prepare them for leadership and becoming a fervent follower of Christ.

There will also be opportunities to serve during weekend celebration services, KidzWorkz & other events. Dates will be given once the church calendar is confirmed.

Applicants will need to be in the program for a minimum period of one year. Upon successful completion of their time as a TASK Force team member, they will be selected to serve as ROAR Helpers.

Seonaid Chio oversees this program and is assisted by a team of very dedicated and experienced ROAR volunteer leaders.

What is TASK Force (TF)?

TASK is an acronym for Training And Serving Kids.

It was launched as part of our on-going commitment to empower and provide opportunities for children to discover and use their God-given gifts and abilities.

Children in Year 7 will be specially selected to be trained, coached and mentored by a team of caring and gifted ROAR leaders for ministry in specific areas of children's ministry for a minimum period of one year.

Upon successful completion of their time as a TASK Force team member, he/she will be selected to serve as a ROAR Helper.

This program will serve as a foundation of a structured leadership training to raise a generation of young leaders who are fervent followers of the Lord Jesus Christ.

What does a TF member do?

A TF member is a leader-in-training. Their participation will be required in some of the KidzWorkz programs during LIFETRAX and ROAR weekend celebration services (**A current Training Schedule will be given upon successful application & once the church calendar is confirmed**). Their tasks will include:

- Be a buddy to new visitors
- Pray and intercede for others
- Preparation of props/activities
- Help to set up/pack up/clean up
- "Have A Go" at platform ministry by through sharing testimonies/devotions.
- Greet children as they come into church, help them find their nametags

Who can apply?

Anyone who is graduating/has graduated from Grade 6 and will be in Year 7. He/she must be willing to commit to the requirements of being a TF member (**see attached Requirements for a TF Member**).

Parental permission must be obtained. (**see attached Application Form**). It is vital that parents/guardians fully support their children in this program. Parents/guardians will need to bring their children to the training sessions and ensure that all assignments are completed as well as ensure that their child maintains his/her spiritual growth in the Lord.

When to apply?

Intakes will be during the third term of the current year.

How to apply?

The child is to complete and send in the TF Application Form (**see attached Application Form**) together with a recent photo to the ROAR Department for the attention of Lilian Low.

What happens next?

The child will be notified of the status of the application and required to undergo an interview with the Children's Pastor or his representative if he/she passes prior selection. There will be further notification if the interview is successful.

What if the child is selected?

If the child secures a place on the TF team, a T-shirt and a training manual for a total cost of \$40.00 (non-refundable) will have to be purchased. If this cost is an issue, please speak to Brett Ryan, the Children's Pastor. The child is then required to attend all training sessions and complete all practical and written tasks.

What is the commitment period?

The commitment period is for a minimum of 1 year.



REQUIREMENTS FOR A TASK Force Member –

- Attend a Youth or Family Life Group
- Attend regular weekend Celebration Services
- Work towards completion of LIFETrax 1 & 2 by year 10
- Be water baptised or be working towards baptism
- Pray and read the Bible regularly
- Maintain the CityLife devotional journal
- Be a good example to other children
- Punctually attend all training sessions
- Have a great attitude and commitment towards ministry
- Show obedience to leaders and respect for other team members
- Demonstrate an ability to interact with others in a team environment
- Successfully complete and achieve competency in all written & practical assignments of training

Please note that if the child is unable to demonstrate a willingness to maintain these requirements, the Children's Pastor will address the issue with the parents/guardian and the child.

If the issue is not resolved satisfactorily in the opinion of the Children's Pastor, the child will be withdrawn from the program.

It is vital that parents/guardians encourage and ensure that their children fulfil these requirements.
